The decision on whether to extradite Julian Assange from the UK to the US is now in the hands of Home Secretary Priti Patel.

His extradition is sought for revealing war crimes, fraud, human rights abuses and corruption around the world.

- and dozens more human rights and free speech organisations.



More than 1800 journalists from over 100 countries have recently denounced his prosecution, calling it a “threat to journalists everywhere”.
